Applications are invited for the post of Shoulder Surgery Fellow commencing on **1st January 2006 and 1st July 2006** for a fixed period of one year. Applicants are expected to have FRCS or equivalent and to be of at least middle grade Registrar standing. Preferably the applicant should be after completion of training or in the last year of training, post FRCS(Orth) or equivalent and close to CCST accreditation, be computer literate, and be able to initiate research projects and set up trials, and also undertake clinical duties as required.

Hours of duty are a standard working week of 40 hours and in addition alternate Monday nights on the Specialist Registrar rota which is currently between £27,483 and £41,733 per annum, depending on verification of previous service.
